To provide consistent and caring mentors to guide, support and inspire formerly incarcerated men and women who participate in this program upon release. It is the mentor's goal to develop the attitudes and skills that will help the participants to be successful in their personal lives, as members of their community and as employees at their place of work.

Our goals are to:

- *Enhance the dignity of participants by encouraging them to make choices that will help them become successful;**
- *Provide participants with the interpersonal support from mentors that will help them solve problems, gain hope and increase their confidence; and**
- *Reduce the rate of recidivism for the program's participants.**

Prison Fellowship believes that no life is beyond the reach of God's power. They envision a future in which countless prisoners, ex-prisoners, and their families are redeemed, restored and reconciled through the love and truth of Jesus Christ. They equip local churches and volunteers to spread the Gospel, and nurture disciples both inside and outside prison walls, so that these men and women become new creations in Christ, and not repeat offenders.
